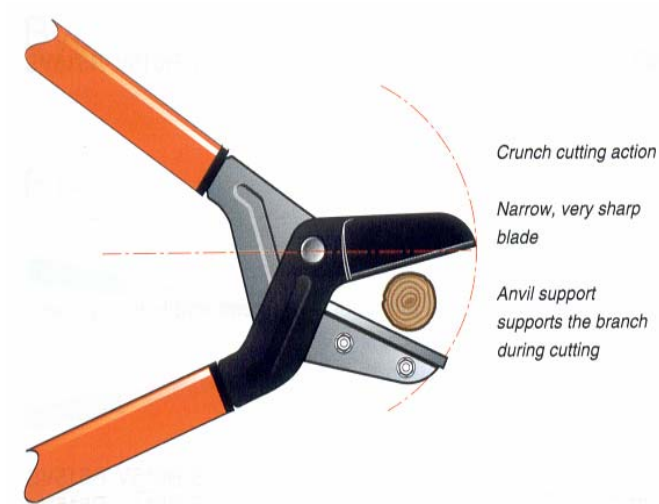

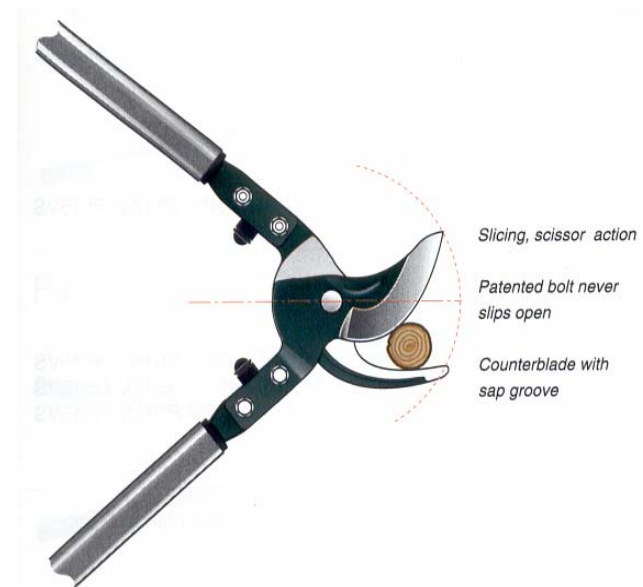

The Anvil Lopper



The Anvil Lopper is designed for cutting old, hard and dead wood. The anvil supports a broad area of the branch while the sharp and narrow blade is forced through the wood with only a minimum amount of slicing motion.

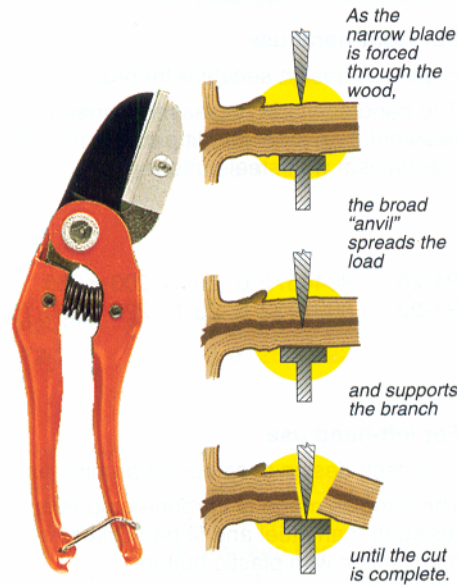
The Bypass Loppers



The Bypass Lopper is designed for cutting live wood. The cutting blade of this lopper slides past a counter blade in a scissor action, hence the name "bypass".

Anvil Pruners

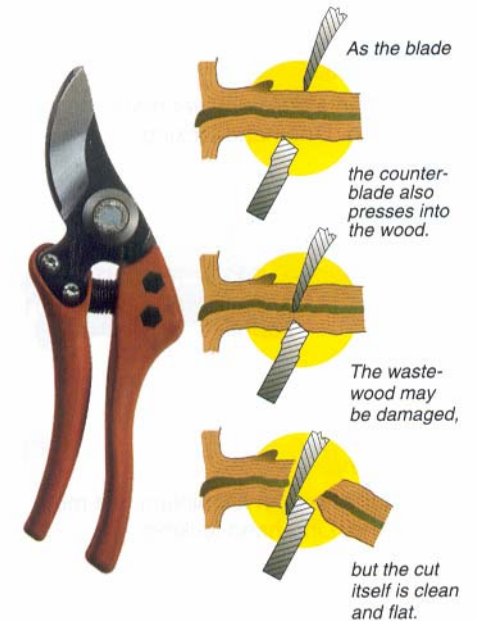
For cutting old and tough wood



The blade of the anvil pruner is narrower and sharper than that of the bypass. When cutting old and hard wood, the blade must be forced through the wood with greater pressure. For this reason the "anvil" which supports the branch and spreads the pressure to reduce damage.

Bypass Pruners

For cutting live wood



This style of pruner owes its name to the fact that the cutting blade "passes-by" the counter-blade in a scissor action.
